Stretching over 1,042 square kilometres, the City of Swan is a diverse and unique blend of residential, commercial, industrial and rural land. The City extends from Ballajura and Malaga in the west to Gidgegannup in the east and from Bullsbrook in the north to Midland, Guildford and Hazelmere in the south. It's not surprising that they're the largest local government in the Perth metropolitan area.

With a population of approximately 150,000 residents in 2018, the City is a thriving hub of economic growth, consisting of some of the fastest growing suburbs in Western Australia, which include Ellenbrook, The Vines, Aveley and the Urban Growth Corridor suburbs of Brabham, Dayton and Caversham. The City of Swan is a major growth area for the North East Metropolitan region which also encompasses the Shire of Mundaring and City of Kalamunda. By 2050, they are expected to accommodate over 60 per cent of the population for this region.
